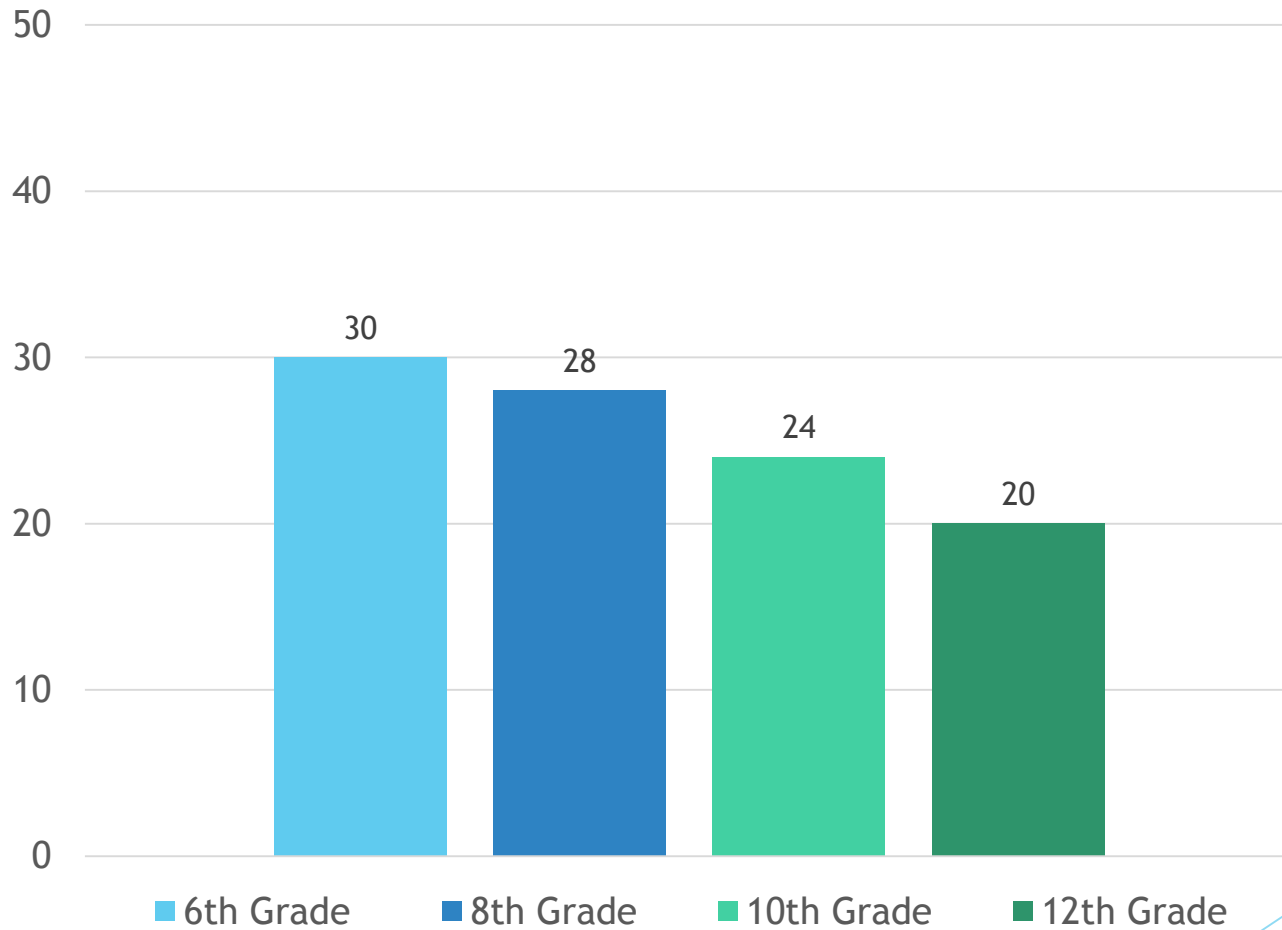

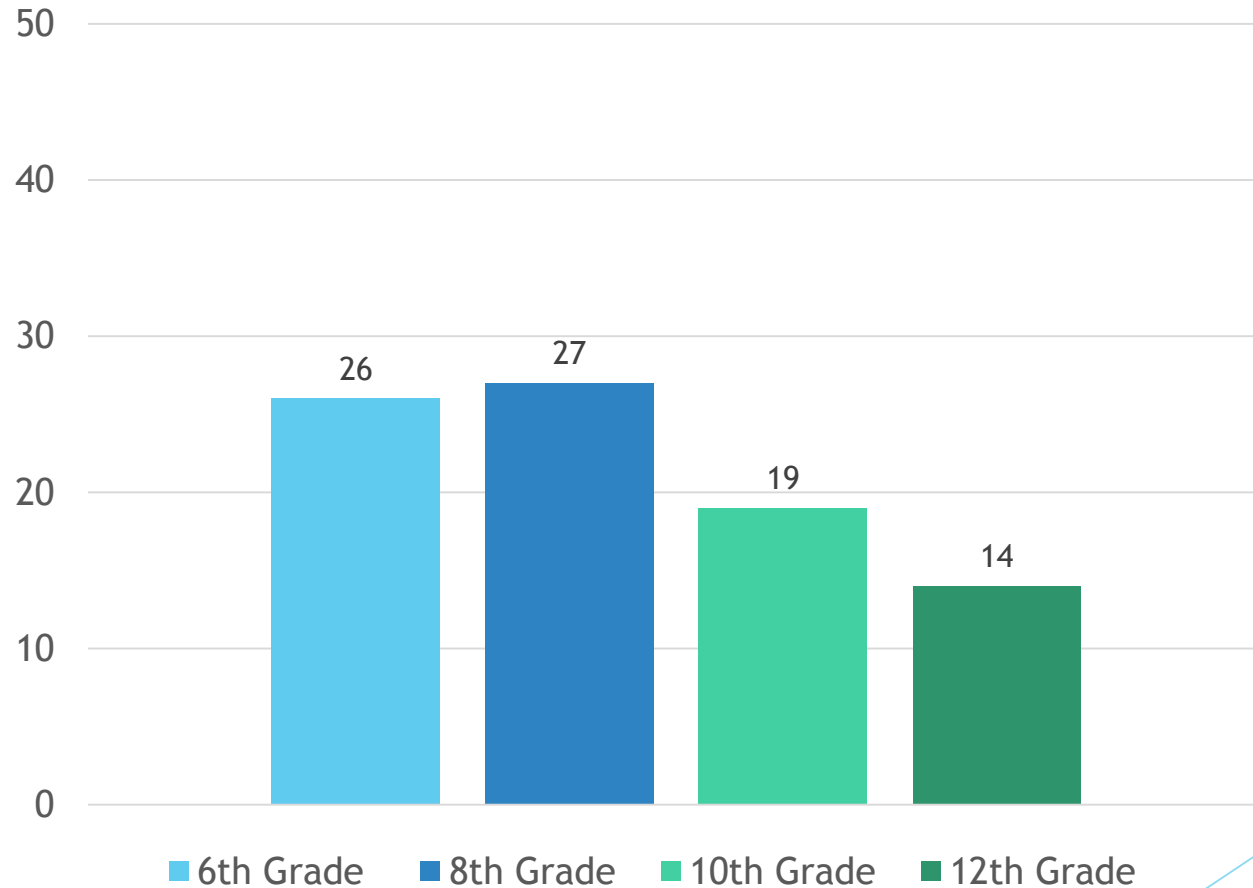

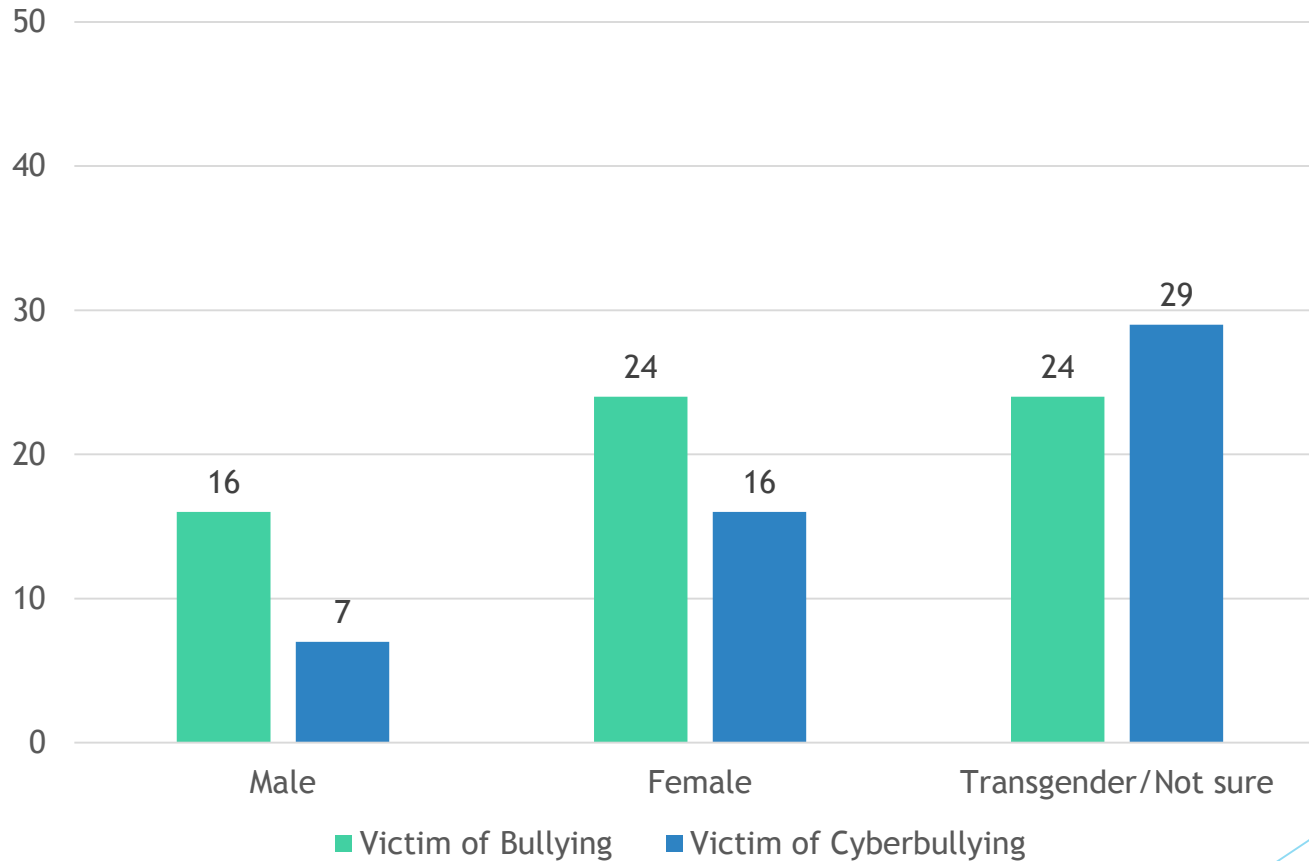
Victim of Bullying at School As Reported by Youth



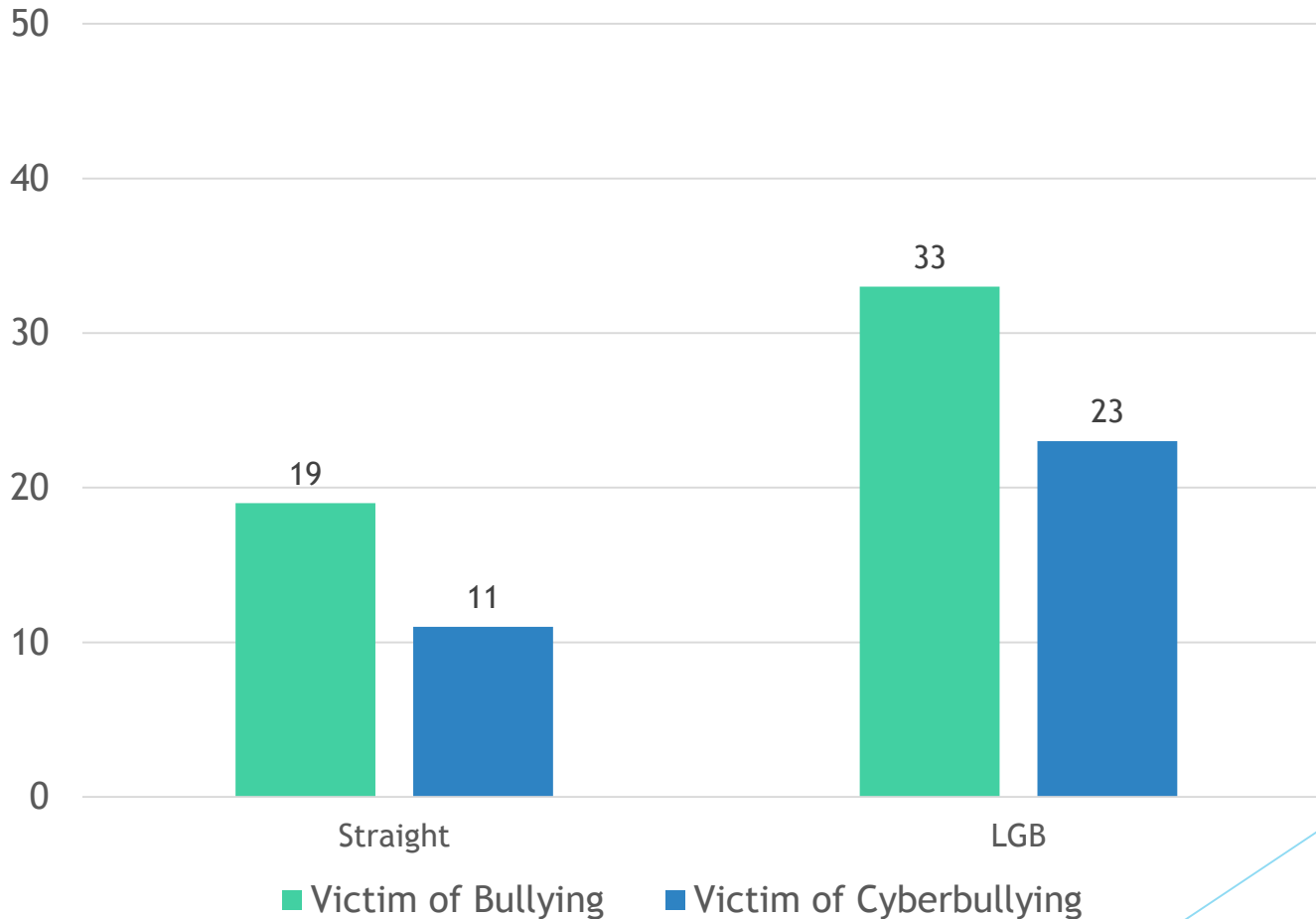
Victim of Bullying in the Community As Reported by Youth

Victim of Bullying - In the Community & Cyberbullying By Sexual Orientation | Grades 8, 10, & 12

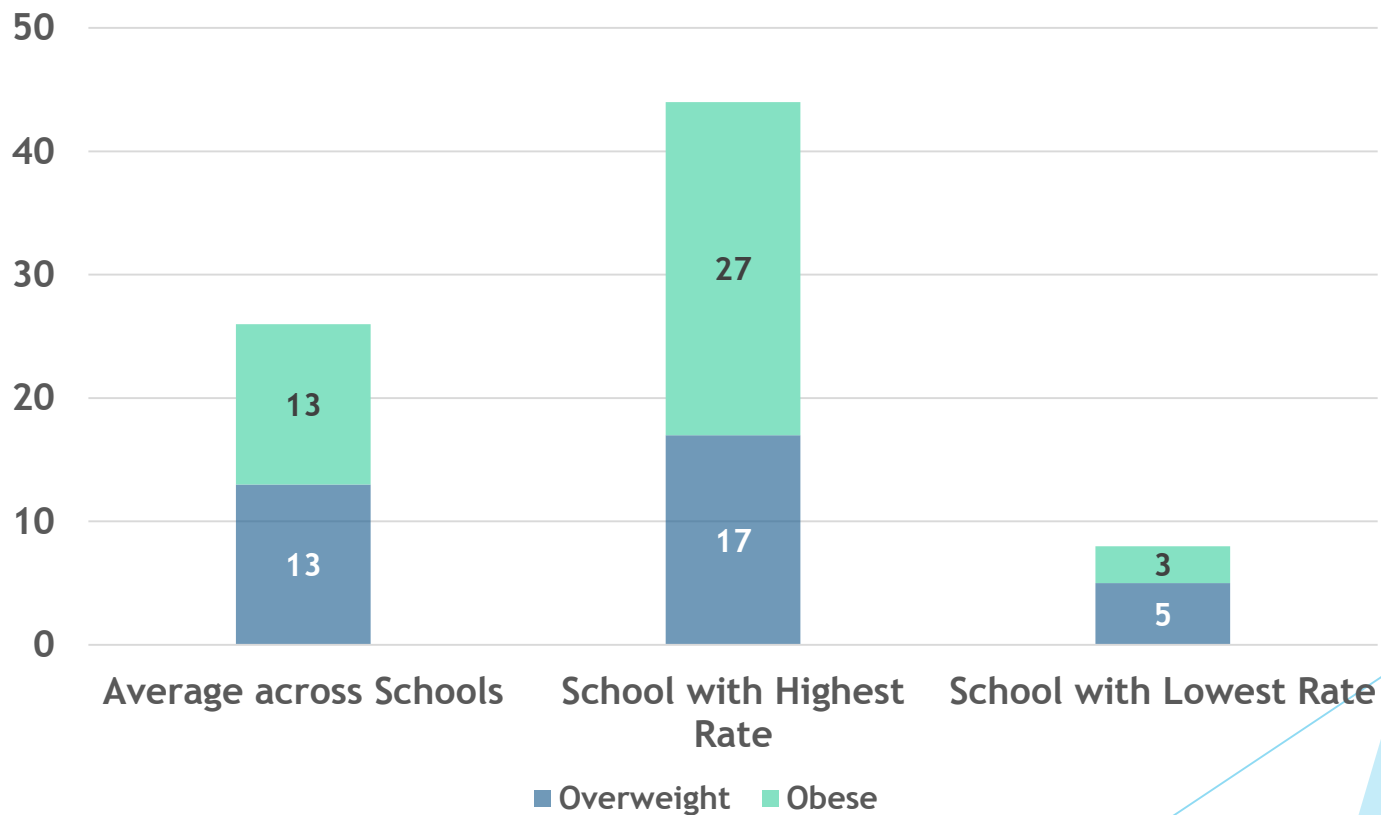

Percent of Obese or Overweight Children Entering Kindergarten

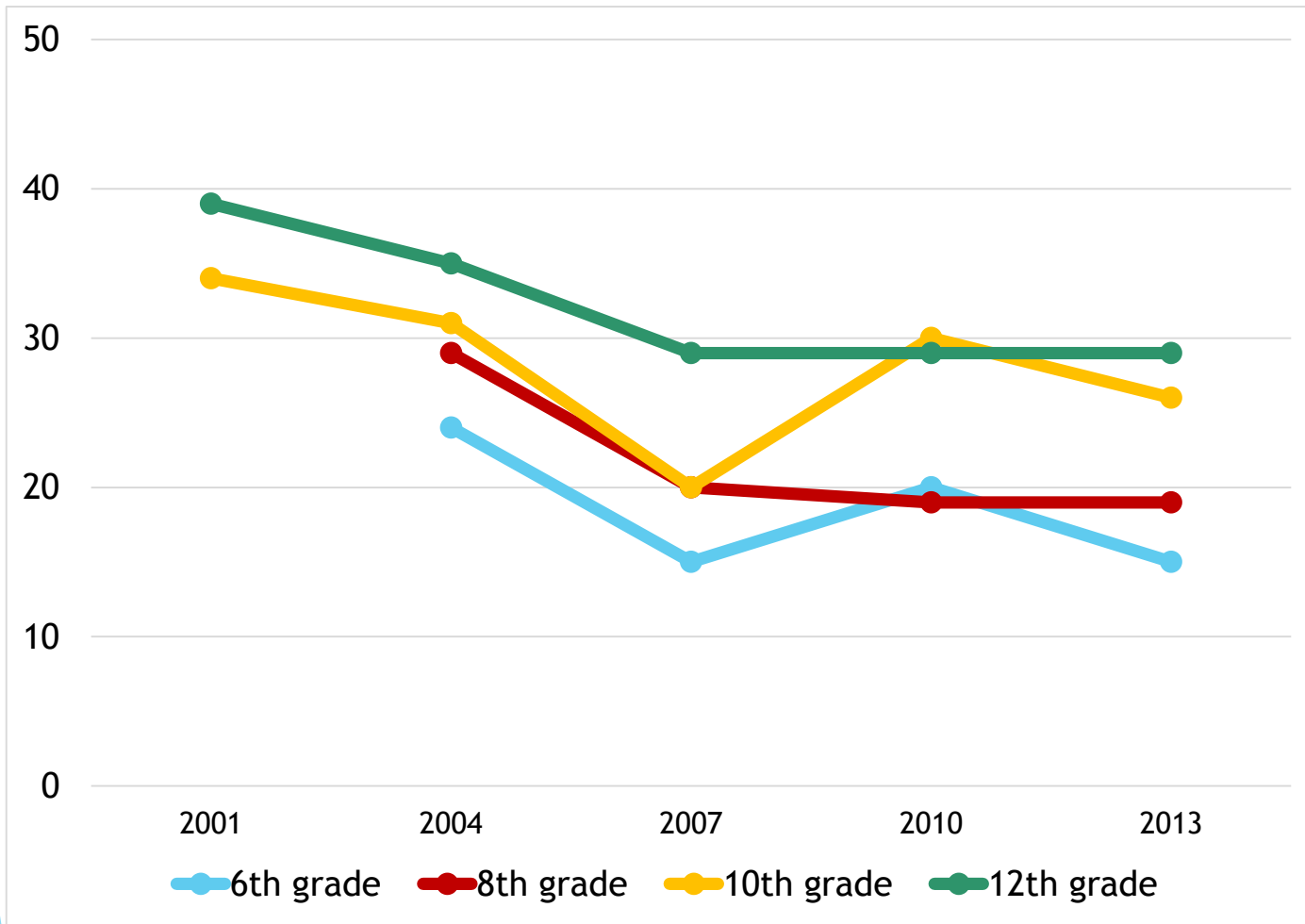

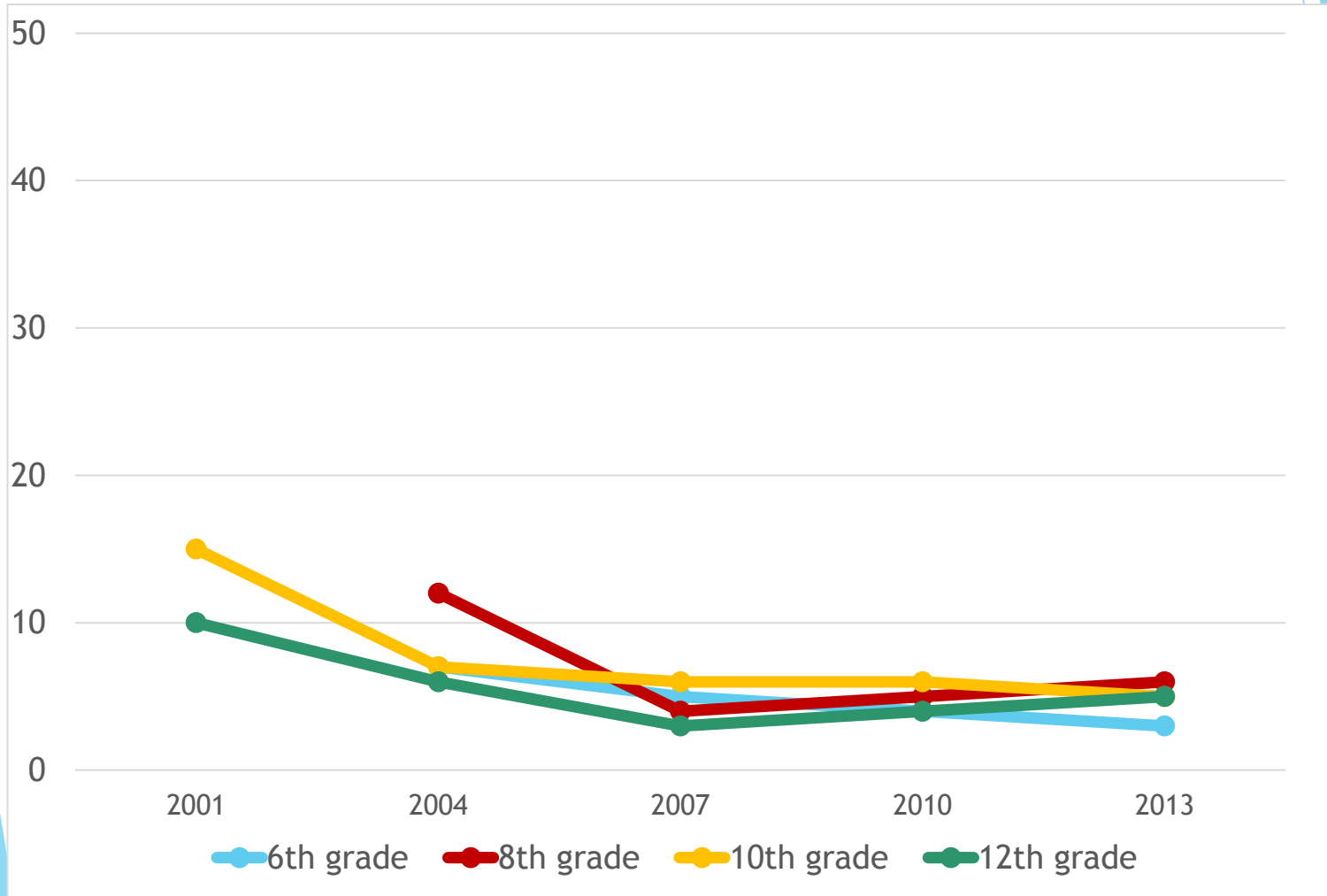

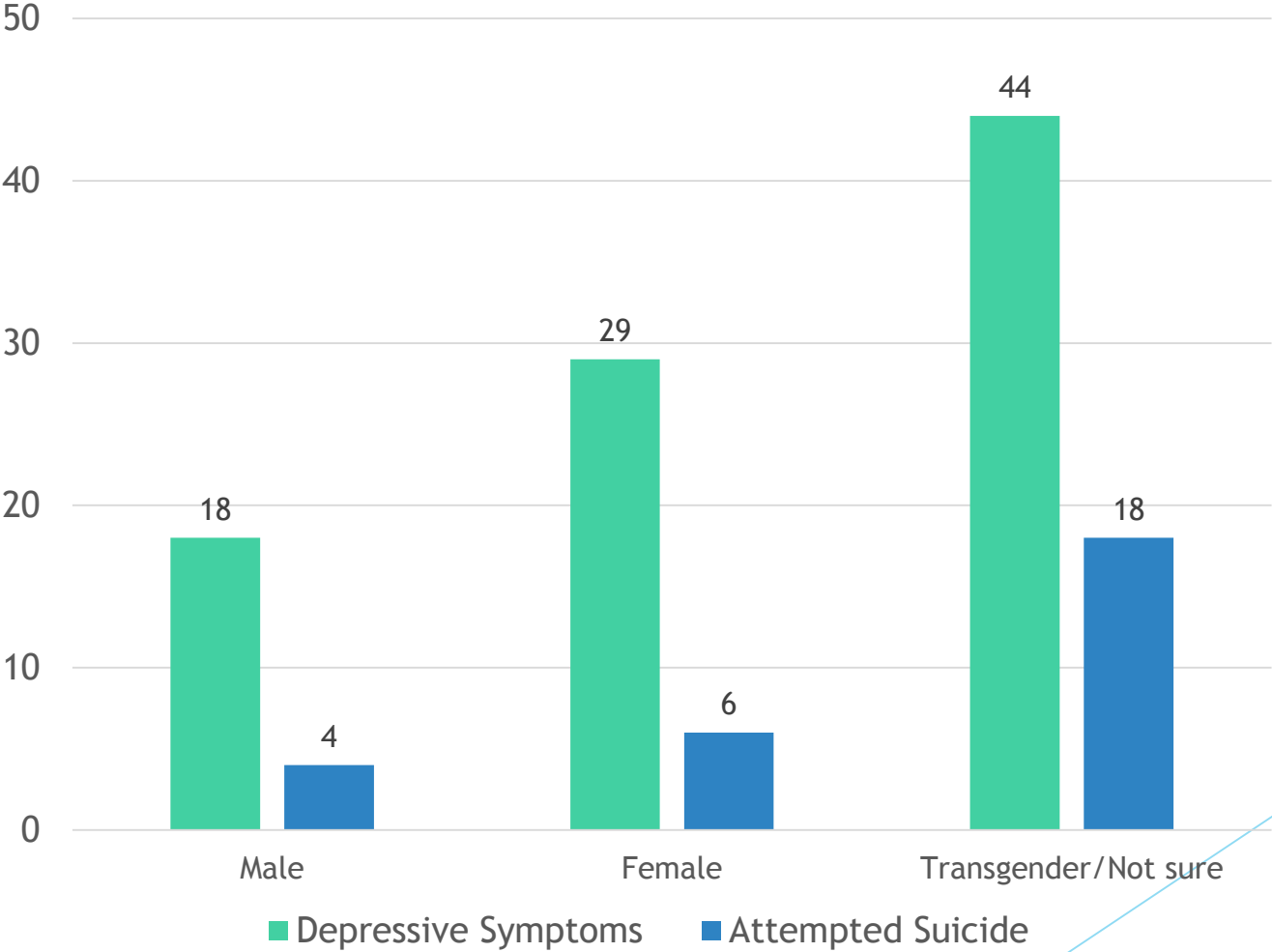
Depressive Symptoms



Attempted Suicide



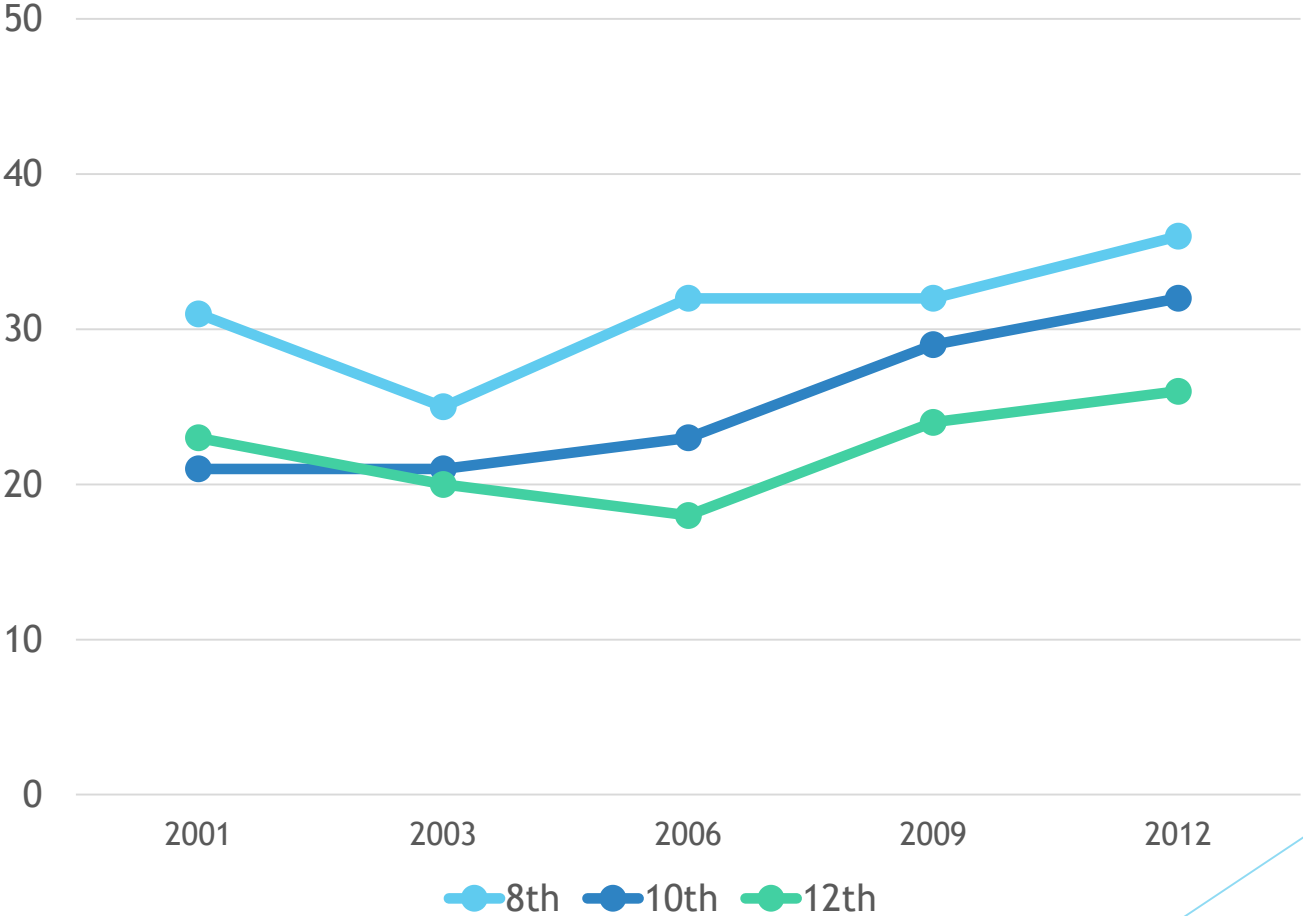
Depressive Symptoms & Attempted Suicide By Gender
